List of Unconsumed Stores and/or all Dutiable Articles owned by the Master, officers and Members of the crew of theMasterfrom

Instructions Masters

1. This list must be completed in readiness to be handed to the Customs officer who first visits the ship. It must be signed by every member of the crew including the master and officers. Each man must state opposite his signature the quantity of dutiable articles in his possession. If he has nothing he must state "nil" or "nothing".
2. The master and officer who remain on a ship during her stay in Mauritius are allowed to retain in their possession 8 days supply of tobacco based on the scale laid down in para. 4 days supply of the other goods mentioned therein. Other members of the crew are entitled to retain 8 days supply of tobacco and 4 days supply of spirits or wine.
3. When the quantity privately owned does not exceed the supplies specified in para. 2, the goods need not be produced, but they must be enumerated on the list. When the quantity exceeds that specified, the whole must be produced to the Customs officer who shall place the excess under seal or release it from charge on payment of the duty. Issues may be made to an individual from any dutiable goods belonging to him that have been placed under seal, or from surplus stores of the ship.
4. Quantities for consumption on board will be issued by the proper officer of Customs from the goods placed under seal, at the following rates when required by the owner:

(a) The Master (per day)	1 ounce	¼ pint (reputed)	1 quart (reputed)	1 quart or 1 pint wine in lieu (reputed)
(b) Mates and Engineers, in the case of passenger ships, the Purser and Chief Steward (per day)	¾ ounce	¼ pint (reputed)	1 quart (reputed)	1 quart or 1 pint wine in lieu (reputed)
(c) Members of the Crew other than the above (per day)	½ ounce	¼ pint (reputed)	1 quart (reputed)	1 quart or 1 pint wine in lieu (reputed)

5. Any dutiable articles, the property of any member of the crew, found in the ship and not enumerated on this list will be liable to forfeiture and the owner thereof to prosecution. Any unconsumed sealable ship's stores not included in this list will also be liable to forfeiture and the omission from the list renders the master liable to a penalty.
6. Tobacco, Cigars, Cigarettes, Spirits or wines, ales or beer left out of stores at the first rummage or afterwards issued will be given individually to each person entitled thereto, and will not be handed out in bulk quantity for subsequent distribution by the master, steward or other person.
7. The master may break the customs seal as soon as a ship has passed beyond the limits of the Harbour of Port Louis on her way to next port of call provided always that all communication with the store has ceased.

Penalty

Any master or member of the crew failing to make a full disclosure of any dutiable goods in his possession shall be liable to a penalty as prescribed by law in force and the goods shall be liable to forfeiture.
