

INVITATION FOR BIDS

PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES (MRA/OABSECURITY/01/19)

A. INTRODUCTION

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) is inviting proposals from prospective eligible and qualified local firms for the provision of Security Services.

B. BIDDING DOCUMENTS

C. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

Bidders are requested to submit their tenders in sealed envelopes clearly marked 'MRA/OABSECURITY/01/19' addressed to the **Director-General, Mauritius Revenue Authority and lodged in the Tender Box, Level 8 - Eham Court, Cnr. Mgr Gonin & Sir Virgil Naz Streets, Port Louis - Mauritius** by **FRIDAY 22 MARCH 2019 not later than 14.00 hours local time**. Bids received through fax and/or electronically will not be accepted.

D. Bids will be opened in the **Conference Room, Mauritius Revenue Authority, Level 8 - Eham Court, Cnr. Mgr Gonin & Sir Virgil Naz Streets, Port Louis - Mauritius** on the same day at **14.15 hours local time** in the presence of bidders/bidder's representative who choose to attend.

E. Proposals received after the prescribed date and time will not be considered.

F. Bidders are being encouraged **to attend a pre-bid meeting** to be held in the **Conference Room - Level 8, Eham Court, Cnr. Mgr Gonin & Sir Virgil Naz Streets, Port-Louis - Mauritius on Wednesday 06 March 2019 at 10.00 hours local time** to raise any matter in the understanding of the requirements of the MRA, submission of documents and related issues. The pre-bid meeting will be followed by a site-visit.

- ii. annul the bidding process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to any bidder.
