# Item: Passenger Boarding Bridges aircraft/Ship

# **Description of goods:**

• Construction and Operation

The bridges consist of a rotunda assembly with two or more rectangular telescopic tunnels with vertical lift columns and wheel bogies and a cabin that is located in front of the bridges. The bogies include electromechanical or hydraulic devices that are so designed for moving the bridges either horizontally, vertically or radially (i.e their telescopic sections, cabin, vertical lift columns, etc), in order to adjust the bridges to the appropriate/ required position to the aircraft's door/cruise ship.

- Purpose: to allow passengers and personnel to walk between:
  - o A terminal building and an aircraft on tarmac; or
- A cruise ship or ferry-boat, without having to go outside.
