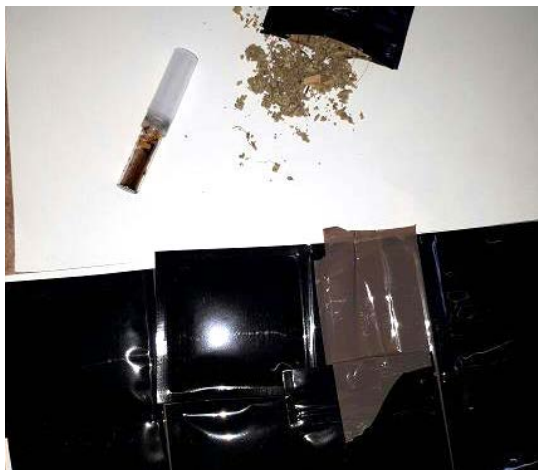


## SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS SEIZED AT THE PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) and ADSU seized 86 grams leaf matter suspected to be Synthetic Cannabinoids at the Parcel Post Office on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2017. The suspected drug was sent from Great Britain in an envelope and was addressed to an inhabitant of Quatre Bornes.

The envelope was tagged by the Customs Anti-Narcotics Section and the result of a field test for Synthetic Cannabinoids was positive. The Customs Sniffer Dog 'Milo' confirmed the presence of the drugs. The drugs were secured and handed over to ADSU for inquiry.
