Clothespins (also known as clothes pegs, or just pegs) are used to hang up clothes for drying, usually on a clothes line. The clothespins are spring-type and often made of plastics, wood or metal.

Clothespins are to be classified as an article according to their constituent material.

Of plastics :	Heading 39.26, Sub Heading 3926.9090
Of wood :	Heading 44.21, Sub Heading 4421.9090
Of metal :	Heading 73.26, Sub Heading 7326.9000

By application of GIR 1 and GIR 6 of the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System.
