SALE OF ABANDONED/UNCLAIMED GOODS BY PUBLIC TENDER QUOTATION NO QUO201804

- 1. The Public is hereby informed that the MRA is holding a sale of abandoned/unclaimed goods by Public Tender on its Online Auction System from 31 January 2018 to 07 February 2018.
- 2. Prospective bidders, other than those already registered, have to register on the Online Auction System by accessing the **e-Auction Sales link** on MRA's Website **www.mra.mu**
- 3. The list of items for sale, which comprises Motor Vehicles and Other Goods, will be posted on our Online Auction System for bidding under Quotation No. QUO201804 on Wednesday 31 January 2018 as from 09.00 hrs. The bidding will close on Wednesday 07 February 2018 at 12.00 hrs.
- 4. The vehicles have never been registered in Mauritius. The successful bidder will have to register his vehicle with the Registrar General in accordance with the Registration Duty Act at his own cost.
- 5. The goods shall be displayed at the Customs Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge and can be viewed on the following dates and time:
 - Wednesday 31 January and Thursday 01 February 2018 Public Holiday No display
 - Friday 02 February 2018 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs.
 - Saturday 03 February 2018 from 09.00 hrs to 12.00 hrs.
 - Monday 05 February to Tuesday 06 February 2018 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs.
 - Wednesday 07 February 2018 from 09.00 hrs to 12.00 hrs.
- 6. All bids on items which require a deposit shall be accompanied by a deposit of at least 10% of the tender offer. Deposit should be by way of banker's cheque drawn in favour of the Director-General, MRA, and deposited in a special tender box that will be placed at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge before the closure of bidding. The cheque should be placed in an envelope mentioning the name of the bidder and the items the deposit is intended to. Personal cheques will not be accepted.
- 7. Three bidding booths with computer terminals will be available at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge for those who do have not access to internet.
- 8. Visitors are requested to bring along their Identity Cards for access at the Port Main Gate.
