
SALE OF ABANDONED / UNCLAIMED GOODS BY PUBLIC TENDER QUOTATION NO. QUO202123

1. The public is hereby informed that the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) is holding a sale of abandoned / unclaimed goods by Public Tender on its Online Auction System from **15 December to 22 December 2021**.
2. Prospective bidders, other than those already registered, have to register themselves on the Online Auction System. (Click [here](#) to register)
3. The items for sale, which comprise **general goods**, will be posted on the [Online Auction System](#) for **bidding** under Quotation No. **QUO202123** on **Wednesday 15 December 2021 as from 09.00 hrs**. The bidding will **close** on **Wednesday 22 December 2021 at 12.00 hrs**.
4. The goods shall be displayed at the Customs Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge and can be viewed on the following dates and time:
 - **Wednesday 15 December to Friday 17 December 2021 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs**
 - **Saturday 18 December 2021 from 09.30 hrs to 12.00 hrs**
 - **Monday 20 December and Tuesday 21 December 2021 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs**
 - **Wednesday 22 December 2021 from 09.00 hrs to 12.00 hrs**.
5. All bids on items which require a deposit shall be accompanied by a deposit representing at least 10% of the tender offer. Deposits should be by way of **banker's cheque** drawn in favour of the Director-General, MRA, and deposited in a special tender box that will be placed at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge **before the closure of bidding**. The cheque should be placed in an envelope mentioning the name of the bidder and the items the deposit is intended to. **Personal cheques will not be accepted**.
6. Three bidding booths, with computer terminals, will be available at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge, for those who do not have access to internet facilities.
7. Visitors are requested to bring along their Identity Cards for access at the Port Main Gate.
