
FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO BUSINESS OPERATORS FOLLOWING INCREASE IN PRICE OF “DIESEL” – MONTHLY STATEMENT

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) wishes to inform Business Operators who have already registered themselves with MRA to benefit from the financial assistance following increase in the price of “Diesel”, that the facility for the submission of Monthly Statements is now available on MRA website: www.mra.mu

Every Business Operator, registered for the financial assistance, is required to submit a **Monthly Statement** providing details of “Diesel” consumed in a month. MRA, after the necessary verifications, will credit the payment directly in their bank account provided on registration.

To access the system, Business Operators are required to insert their **Tax Account Number (TAN)** and **Password** that were used on registration.

Eligible Persons are as follows:

1. Micro, Small and Medium enterprises having a turnover not exceeding Rs. 100 million, based on Income Tax return submitted to MRA for the year of assessment 2022/2023;
2. Bakeries registered with the State Trading Corporation (STC) and benefitting from subsidised price of flour and having a turnover not exceeding Rs. 100 million;
3. Persons holding a Public Service Vehicle Licence (PSVL) for School Van issued by the National Land Transport Authority (NLTA);
4. Small sugarcane planters registered with the Sugar Insurance Fund Board (SIFB); and
5. Small farmers and breeders registered with the Small Farmers Welfare Fund (SFWF).

To benefit from the financial assistance, eligible persons are required to be fully compliant with their tax/social contribution obligations and also keep proper records, documents and invoices. After the payment, MRA may carry out an audit and any excess amount claimed/paid will be claimed back accordingly.

Business Operators are kindly requested to read the instructions and guidelines available on MRA website before submitting the Monthly Statements.
