## **SEIZURE OF 10 TABLETS OF ECSTASY**

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) Customs Department, in collaboration with ADSU, intercepted and seized 10 tablets suspected to be Ecstasy on Tuesday 07<sup>th</sup> March 2017 at the Parcel Post Office (PPO). The consignment containing the 10 tablets was concealed in an aluminum sheet and it was sent from Holland. The tablets were detected by Customs Officers of the Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) upon examination.

The K9 Unit dog, Milo, was called to confirm the suspected drug and the result was positive. The tablets were secured and handed over to ADSU for enquiry. A controlled delivery was carried out and one person was arrested.
