

MRA SEIZES DANGEROUS DRUGS WORTH RS 101,000 AT PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized seven cannabis seeds on Monday, 08 November 2021 and 33.65 grams of cannabis resin on Wednesday, 09 November 2021, both, worth around Rs 101,000, at Parcel Post Office. The drugs parcels were addressed to individuals residing at Curepipe and Mahebourg, respectively.

1. Seven Cannabis seeds were found in five small plastic containers and concealed inside a roll of tissue paper.
2. Two small sachets containing a solid substance weighing 33.65 grams, suspected to be Cannabis resin, were found. K9 sniffer dog Oasis was deployed on the exhibit and reacted positively.

The cases were referred to ADSU for further enquiry and in the former case one person was arrested during a controlled delivery exercise on 10 November 2021.
