MRA SEIZES CANNABIS RESIN AND CRYSTAL METH WORTH RS. 135,000



On Wednesday 24 February 2021, officers of the Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 11.26 grams of cannabis resin and 6.74 grams of crystal meth worth Rs. 135,000 at the Parcel Post Office (PPO). The parcels containing the suspected drugs were addressed to residents of Quartier Militaire and Port Louis and remained unclaimed. Upon examination of the parcels, the CANS officers secured the suspected drugs and the MRA Customs Narcotics Sniffer dogs 'Nacre' and 'Olympia' reacted positively to the substances.

The case has been referred to the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) for further investigation.
