FAKE RECRUITMENT PORTAL

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) draws the attention of the public that its name, and logo are being associated with messages on the social media allegedly issued by the MRA, requesting to apply for job positions.

The MRA, hereby informs members of the public that it has not issued any such aforementioned messages.

The public is hereby cautioned against submitting personal information to any person who claims to represent the MRA and/or its officials or to have a personal or financial relationship with the MRA.

The MRA is endeavouring to raise public awareness on the risks associated with such scams by providing, on its website, information on those scams.

The MRA brings to the attention of the public that it cannot be held responsible if its name and logo are misused in schemes intended to defraud members of the public. Should members of the public feel that they have been scammed, the MRA strongly recommends that they report the matter to the Police.

The public is also encouraged to bring to MRA's attention any such information and suspected communication.
