

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED TO BENEFIT FROM EXCISE DUTY EXEMPTION ON DOUBLE SPACE CABIN VEHICLE AND SINGLE SPACE CABIN VEHICLE

(a) General

- (1) The applicant should have been engaged in any business mentioned below **for the last 2 years**.
- (2) The following documents should be produced (**ORIGINAL + 1 PHOTOCOPY**)

(c) In case of a married couple, if both spouses are engaged in any one of the above activities, only one spouse will be eligible to the duty exemption.

(d) In case the application is made in the name of the heirs of a deceased person, the original and one copy of the affidavit establishing the heirs of the deceased person and of the death certificate should also be submitted.

(e) In case the applicant has benefitted from duty exemption on a pickup vehicle in the past, he should submit the original and one copy of the horse power certificate of the vehicle.
