Minimum and Maximum basic wage for the calculation of NPF and NSF Contributions

Employers are hereby informed that the **minimum and maximum basic wage** on which contributions to the National Pensions Fund (NPF) and National Savings Fund (NSF) are payable, have been reviewed as follows:

Daily	70	111	721
Weekly	420	663	4325
Fortnightly	840	1327	8649
Half Monthly	910	1438	9370
Monthly	1820	2875	18740

For self-employed persons, contributions, if any, should be effected in multiples of Rs 5. The minimum contribution for a month is Rs 185 and the maximum is Rs 1065.

The effective date of the new minimum and maximum NPS/NSF contributions is **01 July 2019**.
