NOTICE

The public is reminded that portable electric lamps commonly known as laser penlights/torches of 1 MW (milliwatt) or more are **prohibited goods** under the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 1999.

Under section 156(1)(b) of the Customs Act any person who imports any **prohibited goods** commits an offence and on conviction is liable –

- (a) to a fine which shall -
 - (i) where the value of the goods does not exceed 1,500 rupees, be 4,000 rupees.
 - (ii) where the value of the goods exceeds 1,500 rupees, be 3 times the value of the goods or 20,000 rupees, whichever is the higher; and
- (b) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 8 years, and the goods subject-matter of the offence shall be liable to forfeiture.
