

## **NOTICE TO STAKEHOLDERS**

## **EXPORT OF SCRAP METAL**

[Consumer Protection (Scrap Metal) Regulations 2019]

Stakeholders are hereby informed of the above-mentioned regulations (**G.N. 151 of 2019**), which has been into operation since **16**<sup>th</sup> **September 2019**.

No person shall export scrap metal unless he -

- (1) <u>holds a Scrap Metal Export Licence</u> issued by the Commerce Division of the Ministry responsible for the subject of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection; or
- (2) is engaged in a manufacturing or recycling business which generates scrap metal as a by-product.

To implement the above measure, exporters, referred in paragraphs (1) and (2), are required to be registered at the MRA Customs by submitting a duly filled application Form MRA/CUS/DR/BG/Form 11, downloadable from the MRA website at <a href="http://www.mra.mu/index.php/downloadable-forms/customs-forms">http://www.mra.mu/index.php/downloadable-forms/customs-forms</a>, together with the documents specified therein.
