



CUSTOMS

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBT, USE THE **RED CHANNEL**

Travellers must use the red channel if they have:

- Exceeded the limit of their normal personal allowances;
- Merchandise for sale;
- Restricted goods;
- Prohibited goods including *Selected Prohibited goods***
- Currency or bearer negotiable instruments, cheques, traveller's cheques and others, or precious stones and metals including gold, diamond and jewellery, or any goods of high value including works of art of an amount **exceeding 500,000 Mauritian rupees or its equivalent in any foreign currency.**

WARNING

Drug trafficking is a serious offence and may lead to severe fine and imprisonment.

GREEN CHANNEL

Passengers may use the green channel if they fall within the following allowances:

- 1. Passengers aged 12 years or over travelling on a Mauritian passport**
 - Goods of a value of up to Rs. 30,000 except merchandise for sale.
- 2. For all other passengers**
 - Goods of a value of up to Rs. 15,000 except merchandise for sale.
- 3. For all passengers aged 18 years and above having in their possession cigarettes and alcoholic beverages falling under any one of the following options:**

Option	Tobacco (including Cigars and Cigarettes) not exceeding:	Spirits not exceeding:	Wine, Ale or Beer not exceeding:
A	250 grams	2 Litres	4 Litres
B	250 grams	3 Litres	NIL
C	250 grams	NIL	6 Litres
