## Seizure of Cannabis and Cannabis Resin at the Parcel Post Office

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized two packages suspected to contain Cannabis and Cannabis Resin at the Parcel Post Office on 01 July 2020. The two parcels were unclaimed and were thus examined. Customs Anti-Narcotics dog Cesar reacted positively to the content.





One package, shipped from UK, was addressed to a shop in Rose Hill and was found to contain about 30g of cannabis resin in an aluminium foil. The other one came from Canada, and was addressed to an individual residing at Tamarin. It was found to conceal about 7.5g of cannabis in the flap of a greeting card.

The market value of the seized drug is estimated at Rs. 95,000. The case has been handed over to ADSU for inquiry.
