MRA SEIZES METHAMPHETAMINE WORTH RS 9.9 M AT A COURIER SERVICE







The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 660 grams of methamphetamine worth around Rs 9,900,000, on Thursday, 03 February 2022 at a Courier Service. The drugs, addressed to a Malagasy residing in Madagascar, arrived in Mauritius on Air Mauritius flight MK2852 of the same day from South Africa.

The courier consignment, consisting of two black files, was in transit in Mauritius. During the examination, two files were found concealing four rectangular plastic parcels secured with brown cello-tape all containing whitish crystals matter suspected to be Methamphetamine. A field test for Crystal Methamphetamine carried out on the substance turned out to be positive.

The case has, subsequently, been referred to ADSU for further enquiry.
