

Rs. 15M Synthetic Drugs seized at a Courier Service





The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized some 1020g of synthetic drugs worth around Rs. 15.3M on the 29th of March 2024 at a Courier service.

The parcel, declared as toners, was targeted for scanning and examination by the MRA Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) Officers, based on established risk indicators.

The parcel was found to contain a certain quantity of an off-white powder sealed in plastic sachets. The latter emitted a pungent smell.

A field test for a synthetic drug was carried out, and same revealed to be positive.

The exhibits were secured and handed over to the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) for further inquiry.

A controlled delivery operation was set up. The latter was later called off as nobody turned up to collect the parcel.
