MRA SEIZES 52 GRAMS OF MDMA WORTH RS 785,000 AT A PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 52.39 grams of MDMA worth around Rs 785,850, on Thursday, 09 March 2022 at Parcel Post Office. The drugs, addressed to a resident of Mahebourg, arrived in Mauritius on Air Mauritius flight MK015, from Paris, on Saturday 06 November 2021.

The postal packet, consisting of a grey envelope contained a white rectangular carton box enclosing a sealed transparent plastic sachet in which there was a significant amount of crystalline substance suspected to be MDMA.

The exhibit was secured and referred to ADSU for further enquiry.
