

MRA SEIZES METHAMPHETAMINE WORTH RS 17 M AT A COURIER SERVICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 1.14kg of Methamphetamine worth around Rs 17 million, on Tuesday, 02 November 2021 at a courier service. The parcel arrived in Mauritius on British Airways flight BA2063 of 02 November 2021 from London.

K9 Sniffer dog “Orage” reacted positively prior to examination of the consignments.

During the examination of a carton box of four paper pouches which was addressed to an individual residing at Flic en Flac, 1.14Kg of brownish matter admixed with whitish crystals suspected to be dangerous drug (Crystal Methamphetamine) were found. A field test for Crystal Methamphetamine on the substance was positive.

The exhibit was secured and handed over to ADSU for further enquiry.
