



MRA AND ADSU INTERCEPT SYNTHETIC DRUGS

The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) and the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) seized 23 grams of Synthetic Cannabinoid worth Rs. 345,000 at the premises of a courier services on Wednesday 28th March 2018.





The suspected drugs were sent in two different parcels from Shanghai, China and were addressed to inhabitants of Rose Hill and Rivière du Poste respectively. The suspected drugs were secured and transferred to the ADSU Head Quarters for safe keeping and further investigation.

This is the fourth seizure of Synthetic Drugs made in 2018 and the market value of the said seizures made amounts to nearly Rs. 100 million. Members of the public may report suspected drug/ illicit activities to the MRA through the Stop Drug platform or by calling on 8958.
