

MRA seizes IPR goods at Customs Freight Station, Port Area

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized intellectual property rights (IPR) goods at the Customs Freight Station, Port Area, on 24 October 2025. The consignment of 27 packages originated from Guangzhou, China.



Following a risk profiling exercise, the consignment was targeted for examination by the Brigades des Marchandises Unit (BDM) of MRA Customs. Upon examination, the following IPR - infringing goods were found and seized: 3930 pieces of Beach Shorts, bearing the *Vilebrequin*.
