

MRA SEIZES HASHISH WORTH RS185 M

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA), in collaboration with the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU), seized 37.1Kgs of suspected Hashish worth Rs 185 M at the SSR International Airport on 15 October 2025.



The passengers were profiled while leaving customs through the green channel. After the usual customs formalities, they were brought to the MRA Customs counter for luggage examination. The male and female British passengers were found in possession of 9 and 10 packets, respectively, each suspected to contain hashish.

The parcels were slightly cut, and each was found to contain similar compressed matter suspected to be hashish.

The MRA CANS Officers have secured the exhibits.

The passengers have been arrested by ADSU. An enquiry by ADSU is in progress.
