MRA seizes hemp oil capsules containing cannabis at Parcel Post Office



On Saturday, 14 August 2021, officers of the MRA Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) opened two suspicious packets labelled "Hemp oil capsules 30000MG" at the Parcel Post Office. Upon thorough examination, it was confirmed that each of the twenty capsules therein, contained cannabis.

One of the parcels was addressed to an individual residing at Cap Malheureux. The case has been referred to the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) for further investigation.
