

CRACKDOWN OPERATION

MRA SEIZES ALCOHOLIC PRODUCTS IN A RETAIL SHOP

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) made a crackdown operation today, 21 February, 2019, at a retail outlet at Pointe aux Sables. Alcoholic drinks comprising beer, local rum, wine and other spirits, worth more than Rs 200,000, were seized.



According to gathered intelligence, the retailer was operating without a proper liquor licence. An operation was mounted, with the assistance of the Mauritius Police Force, to intercept the illicit trade of alcoholic products.

All the alcoholic drinks found at the said premises were seized and secured by the MRA for prosecution purposes.
