

MRA seizes Ecstasy pills



The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 56 ecstasy pills, worth approximately Rs 112,000, on Saturday, 21 October 2023 at a Courier Service. The content of the parcel, in transit, was declared as Health Products. When scanned and examined by Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the MRA, a carton box was found to contain fifty-six (56) green pills. Each pill bore the logo of a Kangaroo.

A field test for Ecstasy was carried out on the substance and the result was positive.

The exhibits have been secured and the case referred to ADSU for further enquiry.
