## **MRA CUSTOMS SEIZES 11 STUN GUNS**







The Examining Unit of the Seaport Operations of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) Customs Department intercepted a consignment of eleven stun guns at the Port on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2018. This is the second seizure of stun guns made by the MRA Customs Department during the month of April. A first seizure of was made on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at a warehouse in Port Louis.

The importation of Stun Gun requires a clearance from the Mauritius Police Force under the Firearm Act, as the former is a Prohibited Goods. Members of the public may report suspected drug/illicit activities to the MRA through the Stop Drug platform or by calling on 8958.
