

MRA SEIZES HEROIN WORTH ABOVE RS 31M

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 2.087 kg of a product suspected to be Heroin worth Rs 31,305,000 on 27 November 2025 at the SSR International Airport from a German national, who was intercepted while leaving customs through the green channel.

After completing customs formalities, the suspect was brought to the MRA Customs counter for a luggage examination during which two (2) parcels suspected to contain Heroin were found in the false bottom of his suitcase.

Subsequently, a controlled delivery exercise was mounted by the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) and one Mauritian was arrested.

The MRA Customs Anti-Narcotics Section, (CANS) Officers have secured the exhibits.

A police enquiry is ongoing.
