MRA SEIZES 55 GRAMS OF METHAMPHETAMINE (MDMA) AND TWENTY HEMP GUMMY BEARS



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 55.3 grams of Methamphetamine (MDMA) worth about Rs 829,500, and twenty 'Hemp Gummy Bears' at the Parcel Post Office on Wednesday, 28 July 2021.

During examination of two parcels which were unclaimed and addressed to two individuals, residing at Mahebourg and Vacoas respectively, the CANS officers secured a CD casing containing a sealed aluminum sachet which contained a certain quantity of crystals substance suspected to be Methamphetamine (MDMA) from the first parcel and from the second one, twenty 'Hemp Gummy Bears' suspected to be Cannabis.

MRA Customs Narcotics Sniffer Dogs 'Oasis' and 'Nacre' reacted positively to the substances.

The case has been referred to the ADSU for enquiry.
