MRA SEIZE 620 GRAMS OF HEROIN WORTH AROUND RS 9.3 MILLION



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) in collaboration with the Anti-Drug Smuggling Unit (ADSU) seized 620 grams of heroin worth approximately Rs 9,300,000 on Sunday, 03 July 2022 at a Courier Service. The drug, addressed to a Mauritian residing at Quatre Bornes, arrived in Mauritius on Air Mauritius flight MK 852 of the Saturday, 02 July 2022 from Johannesburg.

The courier consignment, consisting of Document Holder, was examined and inside the Document Holder, in the two sides, the presence of two rectangular parcels secured with brown cello-tape each containing a certain quantity of whitish powder.

K9 Sniffer dog "Maverick" was deployed on the exhibit and the latter reacted positively.

The case has been referred to ADSU for further enquiry. Following a controlled delivery, two persons, a Mauritian and a Guinean, have been arrested.
