LADY INTERCEPTED WITH STUN GUN AT AIRPORT

A female passenger deplaning from an Air Austral flight from Reunion Island was intercepted by officers of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) Customs Department on Sunday 23 September 2018 at the SSR Airport with a stun gun in





her luggage. The 31 year old Mauritian passenger was leaving through the Green Channel when she was questioned by MRA Customs officers. Her luggage was scanned and, upon examination, a stun gun was secured. The lady, who works as Secretary in a Law Company based in Ebène, revealed that it was her fiancé who had put the gun in her luggage. She was

informed that she had committed an offence under the Firearms Act and she was arrested by Airport Police. The inhabitant of Rose Hill was later released on parole and she was granted bail at the Mahebourg District Court today 24 September 2018.
