

Sanitary Lockdown

MRA ENSURES ONLINE SERVICES

With the announcement of the new national sanitary lockdown effective in Mauritius from 10 March, 2021, the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) wishes to inform the public that the following **ONLINE** facilities are available on MRA's website, www.mra.mu:

- electronic submission of Returns (Income Tax, VAT, Contribution and other returns),
- electronic payment of taxes, if any, and
- the issuance of Tax Residence Certificate (TRC).

Facilities to apply for financial assistance under the Government Wage Assistance Scheme (GWAS) and the Self-employed Assistance Scheme (SEAS) for the month of March, 2021, wherever applicable, are also available on the website of the MRA: www.mra.mu.

Moreover, the processing of VAT and income tax refund/repayment, wherever applicable, will continue during the lockdown period.

The head-office of the MRA at Ehram Court, Port Louis, and the office at Belfort Tower are closed, as a result of the lockdown. However, a team of officers are working from home to ensure the delivery of essential services provided by the MRA, including the implementation of GWAS and SEAS.
