

MRA SEIZES FIVE VIALS CONTAINING CANNABIS OIL AT A COURIER SERVICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized five vials containing cannabis oil on Wednesday 13 July 2022 at a courier service. The drug, addressed to an individual residing Quatre Bornes, arrived in Mauritius on Air Mauritius flight MK 852 of the Tuesday, 12 July 2022 from South Africa.

The parcel, declared as bath scrub and certificate, was examined and it was found to contain a raphia bag comprising dried noddle sachets, chocolates, lip balms and 5 vials of yellowish liquid, suspected to be Cannabis oil.

A field test for cannabis was carried out on the liquid and it revealed to be positive.

The case has been referred to ADSU for further enquiry.
