

COMMUNIQUE

SALE OF ABANDONED/UNCLAIMED GOODS BY PUBLIC TENDER QUOTATION NO QUO201603

- 1. The Public is hereby informed that the MRA is holding a sale of abandoned/unclaimed goods by Public Tender on its Online Auction System from 11 October 2016 to 18 October 2016.
- 2. Registration as a bidder, which is mandatory, is open to members of the public who are 18 years old and above including foreign citizens. Prospective bidders shall register and submit their bids on the Online Auction System by accessing the **e-Auction Sales** link on the MRA's website **www.mra.mu**. The link shall be available to the public for **registration purposes** only as from Monday 10 October. Bidding by tender forms will not be accepted.
- 3. The list of items for sale, which are categorized, will be posted on the Online Auction System for **bidding** under quotation no **QUO201603** on Tuesday 11 October 2016 as from 09.00 hours. The bidding will be closed on Tuesday 18 October 2016 at 13.00 hours. List of conditions for bidding is posted on the home page of the Online Auction System.
- 4. Goods which cannot be viewed on the Online Auction System shall be displayed at the Customs Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge on the following dates and hours:
 - Tuesday 11 October to Friday 14 October and Monday 17 October from 09.00 hours to 15.00 hours.
 - Saturday 15 October from 09.30 to 12.00 hours and on Tuesday 18 October from 09.00 to 13.00 hours.
- 5. All bids on items which require a deposit shall be accompanied by a deposit of at least 10% of the tender offer. Deposit should be by way of banker's cheque drawn in favour of Director-General, MRA and deposited in a special tender box that will be placed at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge. The cheque should be placed in a special envelope mentioning the name of the bidder and the items the deposit is intended to. Personal cheques shall not be accepted
- 6. Three bidding booths with computer terminals will be available at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge for those who do have not access to internet facility
- 7. Visitors are requested to bring along their Identity Cards for access at the Port Main Gate.
