

JOINT OPERATION BY MRA AND ADSU: SEIZURE OF 3.12 KG OF HEROIN WORTH RS 46.8 M

The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) and ADSU seized 3.12 Kg of heroin worth Rs 46.8 million on-board cargo vessel 'MSC Ivana' on Tuesday 11 May 2021 in the Port-Louis Harbour, during a joint operation. The cargo vessel arrived in Mauritius on Monday 10 May 2021 from South Africa. After a search carried out by both authorities, two parcels suspected to contain heroin were found concealed on board.

The parcels have been secured and enquiry is being carried out by ADSU.
